By car

For SatNav users our postcode is **SO45 1BR**

We are only ten miles from the motorway network, 2 hours from London, Birmingham, Bristol and only 45 minutes from Portsmouth and Bournemouth. Southampton is 30 minutes by road and has both a main-line railway station and regional airport.

From Southampton, follow A326 Fawley and the brown tourist signs for Calshot Activities Centre and Castle.
