

## DIRECTIONS



### By road

From Brockenhurst on the A337 - on reaching Lymington at the mini roundabout continue straight on along Southampton Road until you reach the traffic lights. Turn left at the traffic lights into Avenue Road. The Town Hall can be found 500 yards ahead on the right hand side.

On entering the grounds, the (free) visitors parking can be found on the left hand side. If this is full, members can park at the front of the building if bays are available.

There is step-free access from the car park through to the Council Chamber.

#### By rail

The closest train station is Lymington Town; the train stops here about once an hour and it is a 10 - 15 minute walk to the Town Hall.

When you leave the station walk straight ahead up Station Street to the next junction, turn right into Gosport Lane and continue straight at the mini roundabout to the next mini roundabout, turn left into East Hill which becomes Avenue Road. The Town Hall is on your left just past the Hospital Infirmary (which is on the right).
