

By rail

From Lymington Town railway station (10-15 minutes): walk straight ahead up Station Street to the next junction, turn right into Gosport Lane and continue straight at the mini roundabout to the next mini roundabout, turn left onto the B3054 (East Hill, which becomes Avenue Road). The Town Hall is up the hill on your left.
