Natural England currently working on 15 sections of Coastal Path of those 3 sections are now open in Dorset, Hartlepool and Cumbria with a further section to be opened in Norfolk this year. A further two sections will be presented to the Secretary of State later this year for signing. To date 1,300 miles is being consulted on or at the stage of walking the coarse.
