## By Train

Brockenhurst station is on the mainline from London Waterloo and there is a connection to Lymington Town station which is a 10 minute walk to our offices. Alternatively you can take a short bus or taxi ride from Brockenhurst station to Lymington Town Hall. You should allow 15 minutes for the taxi journey. The nearest bus stop is located on Southampton Road (A337) near to Lymington Police Station which is a five minute walk to our offices.

## By road

**From London and the north:** take M3 South towards Southampton, M27 westbound towards Bournemouth. Exit at Junction 1 and follow the A337 to Lyndhurst, Brockenhurst and Lymington.

**From Bournemouth and the west:** take the A35 to Christchurch and then follow the A337 to Lymington **From Southampton and the East:** take M27 westbound towards Bournemouth. Exit at Junction 1 and follow A337 to Lyndhurst, Brockenhurst and Lymington.
