### By road

**From London and the north:** take M3 South towards Southampton, M27 westbound towards Bournemouth. Exit at Junction 1 and follow the A337 to Lyndhurst, Brockenhurst and Lymington.

**From Bournemouth and the west:** take the A35 to Christchurch and then follow the A337 to Lymington

**From Southampton and the East:** take M27 westbound towards Bournemouth. Exit at Junction 1 and follow A337 to Lyndhurst, Brockenhurst and Lymington.
